Goblin spiders are tiny arachnids belonging to the family Oonopidae, commonly found in leaf litter and under stones in forests and other humid environments. Measuring only 1 to 3 millimeters in length...

- Goblin spiders are so tiny that many species were only discovered in the last few decades using microscopes.
